Description of character of service

Angel Radio is for over 60s resident in Havant. It provides a voice for the over 60s and accentuates the positive aspects of old age. It provides an uplifting, nostalgic entertainment service that mixes music, humour and memories of years gone by with current relevant information, and by supporting local initiatives.

The service broadcasts:

- Music. The main types of music broadcast over the course of each week are: popular music released between 1900 and 1959.
- Speech. The main types of speech output broadcast over the course of each week are: events diary, community-focussed information, local weather forecasts, a range of relevant information items and reminiscence therapy.
- The service provides original output¹ for a minimum of 10 hours per day.
- The service provides locally-produced output² for a minimum of 13 hours per day.

The studio is located within the licensed coverage area.

The service provides a range of community benefits (social gain objectives mandated by statute) for the target community, both on-air and off-air, and in doing so, achieves the following objectives:

- the facilitation of discussion and the expression of opinion,
- the provision (whether by means of programmes included in the service or otherwise) of education or training to individuals not employed by the person providing the service, and
- the better understanding of the particular community and the strengthening of links within it.

Members of the target community contribute to the operation and management of the service.

The service has mechanisms in place to ensure it is accountable to its target community.
