Description of character of service

NuSound Radio is for the residents of Forest Gate and surrounding areas of Newham. The service is inclusive in nature and provides listeners from all background with social gain through the promotion of healthy living and providing training opportunities.

The service broadcasts:

- Music. The main types of music broadcast over the course of each week are: music from the Indian sub-continent together with popular music drawn from other parts of the world.
- Speech. The main types of speech output broadcast over the course of each week are: discussion and debate on local issues, interviews, local news, community information, local travel news and information about local events.
- Over the course of each week, programming in English is broadcast alongside output in languages spoken in the local community.
- The service provides original output¹ for a minimum of 12 hours per day.
- The service provides locally-produced output² for a minimum of six hours per day.

The studio is located within the licensed coverage area.

The service provides a range of community benefits (social gain objectives mandated by statute) for the target community, both on-air and off-air, and in doing so, achieves the following objectives:

- the facilitation of discussion and the expression of opinion,
- the provision (whether by means of programmes included in the service or otherwise) of education or training to individuals not employed by the person providing the service, and
- the better understanding of the particular community and the strengthening of links within it.

Members of the target community contribute to the operation and management of the service.

The service has mechanisms in place to ensure it is accountable to its target community.

¹ Original output is output that is first produced for and transmitted by the service, and excludes output that was transmitted elsewhere before. Original output can be live or voice-tracked. Repeat broadcasts of original output do not count towards the minimum requirement.

² Locally-produced output is any output made and broadcast from within the service's licensed coverage area. It may include all types of local production.
